About ECFSC's Learn to Skate program

Learn to Skate lessons are open to persons age 3 and above, including adults. Beginners and those with experience are invited to participate, with groups being based on age and ability. Lessons include 30 minutes of group instruction and 15 minutes of practice skating. Using the United States Figure Skating (USFS) Basic Skills Program, professional skating instructors will teach and/or reinforce proper skating form. An ECFSC skater will often assist the instructors.

We implement the USFS "Snow Plow Sam" program for our youngest skaters. This program introduces preliminary skating moves in a fun atmosphere, allowing the young skaters to progress more quickly through badge levels.

\$75 REGISTRATION FEE INCLUDES: Instruction, ice time, USFS Basic Skills Book, enrollment in the USFS Basic Skills Program, and official USFS badges.

Classes on Sundays, 4:30 - 5:15 OR 5:00 - 5:45 (We schedule groups after registrations are in.)

MORE INFORMATION FOR LEARN TO SKATE PARENTS

- Please arrive at the rink approximately 15 minutes before the lesson or practice time. This will give you time to get your skater ready for the session.
- We suggest warm, layered clothing and gloves or mittens, even in summer.
- **Skaters must bring their own skates. Skate rental is not available for Learn to Skate.**
- During the 15-minute practice time, one parent or other responsible adult may skate with each Learn to Skate participant. **We cannot allow non-adult siblings on the ice unless they are registered in Learn to Skate. Everyone on the ice must wear skates.**
- Parents are not *required* to skate during the practice times. ECFSC skaters are available to skate with any participants who need extra help or supervision. Please let the coordinator or head instructor know that you would like an assistant for your child.
- Parents may not enter the ice during the regular lesson time, unless they are also Learn to Skate students. This is USFS policy and we cannot make exceptions.
- You will receive a USFS Basic Skills badge book at the end of your first Learn to Skate session. Please retain this book and return it during subsequent sessions.
- We make every effort to operate our program at the times indicated. However, occasionally events at the rink cause brief delays. We regret any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding!
- No refunds are given for missed lessons. If you must drop the class after the first session, we will not provide a refund but will credit you for a future session.
